Formaldehyde is a potential cancer hazard and a known skin and respiratory sensitizer. Vapors irritate the eyes, nose and throat. Safe handling conditions may be maintained by keeping formaldehyde vapor concentrations below the OSHA permissible limit.

Skin contact: Causes skin irritation.

Eye contact: Causes serious eye irritation.

Ingestion: Not expected under normal conditions of use. May cause gastrointestinal tract irritation if swallowed.
